- 1. That I first met Charles Goldblum on or about April 1976 when he and I were incarcerated at the Allegheny County Jail.
- 2. That I first met Clarence Miller on or about 1976 when he and I were incarcerated in the "hole" at Western Penitentiary, and he was a janitor.
- 3. That Clarence Miller admitted to me and about 30 others in the "hole" that he (Miller) committed the murder of George Wilhelm and that he (Miller) did not even know why Goldblum was there in jail.
- 4. That Miller told me he cooperated with the police because he was scared of them; specifically, Detective Ron Freeman who "forced 'stuff' upon Miller."
- 5. That Miller told me that Detective Ron Freeman put so much pressure on him (Miller), threatening him with, "I can see that you get the chair, and other horrible things like that."
- 6. That Miller told me that he (Miller) told Detective Ron Freeman "just what Freeman told him (Miller) to say."
- 7. That Miller told me that "all the words that came out of his mouth, Freeman put them in there."
- 8. That Miller told me that "Zeke didn't kill anybody."
- 9. That Miller told me and others that he killed Wilhelm over money.
- 10. That Miller told me and others that he was hired by Goldblum to burn-down Goldblum's restaurant.

- 11. That Miller told me that Goldblum was set-up, and everything was contrived by Detective Ron Freeman.
- 12. That I met Andrew Kinser Bey while at Western Penitentiary.
- 13. That Bey told me that "there was a chance for him to make some money. He tried to shake Goldblum down for some money."
- 14. That I heard from others that Bey had cooperated with police.
- 15. That I observed private contact and conversations between Bey and Freeman on a couple occasions while in jail.
- 16. That inmate Stanton Story was also in the "hole" and heard Miller confess that he killed Wilhelm and that Miller cooperated with Detective Ron Freeman.
- 17. That it seemed to me that "somebody was in Bey's ear to put Zeke away."
